"Nature & Technology Journal" (Revue Nature et Technologie) (NATEC) is a multidisciplinary, peer-reviewed and scientific open access journal which publishes, in English or French, research papers, literature reviews, and communications that meet the general criteria of significance and scientific excellence. NATEC is biannually issued publication which consists of three sections: Agronomics and Biological sciences, Fundamental and engineering sciences, and Environmental sciences. The journal covers research studies related to the three fields including some of the allied subjects.

All papers must meet the criteria of originality and scientific quality. Obviously, they must also comply with style and format requirements. The paper will not be subject to further review, if the manuscript is not within the scope.

1. The structure for the article:

The text must be elaborated in Word for Windows (Word 6.0 or later) format with moderate margin, using 10 point Times New Roman letters. The optimal length of the manuscript is 6-15 A4 pages, including figures, tables and bibliography/references.

The structure of the manuscript (recommended) must generally have the following parts:: Title, names and surnames of the authors, the institution to which they belong, abstract (150-250 words with keywords /no more than six keywords/), introduction (it can be divided into some subchapters if needed), methodology applied in the investigation (it is recommended to divide /rubricate), results, discussion, conclusions and/or implications, acknowledgements (if any), references (in APA style) (the list should be arranged in alphabetical order between right brackets); appendix (if any).

The articles written in French must have abstracts in English (150-250 words) with keywords also in English. When acronym is used first time in the text its full title is presented.

All authors must take care of the language revision on their own. The work should be written in an impersonal style. The editor reserves the right to send the manuscript to be reviewed. If English is a second language for the author, please consider having the manuscript proof read and edited before submitting.

2. Editorial procedures:

- Nature & Technology Journal follows a double-blind peer review process, whereby authors do not know reviewers and vice versa.
- The submitted manuscript is acknowledged within 48 hours upon receipt.

- Upon submission, a paper will be internally assessed by some of our editors. If the paper is deemed to be of inferior quality, poor presentation or unsuitable for the journal, the submission will be rejected without full refereeing, and a rejection response will be sent to the submitting author via ASJP. The article is suitable for publication if it receives at least two positive reviews.
- The journal aims to offer the fastest possible speed of publication. The review process takes approximately three weeks for a 1st lecture, and three months to final decision.
- All contributors who do not meet the criteria for authorship should be listed in an Acknowledgements section
- The submission of a manuscript previously rejected by the journal will generally not be considered for publication until it is reformulated with a new title

4. Publication Ethics Statement

The ethic statement **of our journal** complies with the Principles of <u>Transparency and Best Practice in Scholarly Publishing</u> as described by the Committee on Publication Ethics (<u>COPE</u>) for Journal Editors:

a. International Standards for Authors:

Authors must:

- Certify that their manuscripts are their original work.

b. International Standards for Editorial Board:

The Editorial Board must:

- Keeps information pertaining to all submitted manuscripts confidential.
- Be responsible for making publication decisions for submitted manuscripts.
- Strive to meet the needs of readers and authors.
- Evaluate manuscripts only for their intellectual content based on their novelty, technical quality, potential impact, and clarity of writing.
- Strive to constantly improve their journals.
- Maintain the integrity of the academic record. The Editorial Board must disclose any conflicts of interest and preclude business needs from compromising intellectual and ethical standards.
- Always be willing to publish corrections | clarifications | retractions and apologies when needed.

c. International Standards for Reviewers:

Reviewers must:

- Keeps information pertaining to the manuscript confidential.
- Bring to the attention of the Editor Board any information that may be a reason to reject the publication of a manuscript.
- Evaluate manuscripts only for their intellectual content
- Objectively evaluate the manuscripts based only on their originality | significance and relevance to the domains of the journal.
- Notify Science Publishing Group of any conflicts of interest.
