

Guidelines for Authors

Authors are urged to present their paper according to the following Instructions for authors:

1. Title :

The title of the paper should be concise, sufficiently informative and given with as many meaningful terms as possible, but limited to about twelve words or 100 characters, avoiding abbreviations, formulae and terms like "Study of.....", "New.....", etc.

2. Authors and affiliation:

Authors' full names with at least one forename spelled out for every author, the names and addresses of their institutions, telephones, faxes and email addresses, should follow the paper title. Indicate all affiliations with a lower-case superscript letter immediately after the author's name and in front of the appropriate address. Indicate the corresponding author by an asterisk just after his name, ensuring that telephone and fax numbers (with country and area code) are given along with the e-mail address and the full postage address.

3. Abstract:

An abstract of about 300 -500 words should be included and be as informative as possible, avoiding any experimental details or detailed values presentation. The abstract should not contain tables, figures, references and sentences of the introduction.

4. Keywords:

A maximum of 5 meaningful keywords should be listed, preferably in alphabetical order, avoiding abbreviations and using keywords of a maximum of three words.

5. Main Text:

Manuscripts should be original and never been published, Manuscripts must be submitted as a Word file, and cannot exceed 20 pages (5000 words, simplifies Arabic 14 and 16 for titles, New Times 12 for English and French, 1.15 for interlines), including the Abstract but excluding references and figure legends.

6. Footnotes

May be cited at the end of the paper.

7. Arbitration

Contributions will be arbitrated by a specialized scientific commission. Manuscripts not meeting these specifications will be returned for modification. .

Journal keeps the right to publish texts according to the editorial plan and according to time as it deems appropriate.

Manuscripts published in this journal reflect only opinions of their authors and do not necessarily reflect the opinion of the journal.

8. Norms of Evaluation

- The value of research and the extent of its originality,
- The extent of Scientific Honesty, and taking into account the traditions of bibliographic documentation and Footnotes.
- The safety of the language of research.
