## Peer Reviewing

All articles submitted for publication in the Algerian Journal of Research and Studies undergo an initial review by the editorial board to assess their adherence to publication guidelines, including conformity to the journals' template. If the submission passes this stage, it is then assigned to at least two external experts, not affiliated with the authors' institution, ensuring impartial evaluation according to internationally recognized scientific and methodological standards. Articles may receive one of the following decisions: acceptance, acceptance with minor revisions, acceptance with major revisions, or rejection.

## Publication Conditions

The editorial board is pleased to receive scientific articles specialized in various humanities and social sciences disciplines, in Arabic, English, or French. These articles are subject to the standards and conditions of peer review in academic scientific research, by specialists, and they comply with the standards of peer-reviewed scientific journals. The submitted texts must meet the following conditions:

1. The journal publishes original scientific research within the field of humanities (spanning areas such as communication and media sciences, history, library science, archaeology, philosophy, religious studies, physical education and various languages such as English, French and Arabic, etc.) and social sciences (including psychology, sociology, anthropology, etc.), in one of the three languages: **Arabic, English, or French**.
2. Submissions must be original and unpublished, adhering to the criteria and standards of scientific research. The author pledges this in writing.
3. Once a research paper or any part of it has been approved for publication in the Algerian Journal of Research and Studies, it may not be published elsewhere without obtaining written permission from the publishing director.
4. The author's consent to transfer all copyrights to the journal is required. Should the journal wish to republish the research, it must seek written approval from the author.
5. Authors must acknowledge the sources of their research.
6. Scientific articles that meet the requirements are assigned to at least two external reviewers who are not affiliated with the author's institution. Thus, the editorial board makes the final decision on whether to accept or reject the article based on their evaluations.
7. The journal publishes concise summaries (up to 3000 words) of PhD and Master's theses in the humanities and social sciences, provided that the research has not been previously published in books or other scientific journals.

8. The journal publishes detailed reports on national and international scientific conferences in the fields of humanities and social sciences, up to a limit of 4000 words.
9. The journal publishes scholarly critical reviews of books or works in the fields of humanities and social sciences that have been recently published or are about to be published, showcasing an appropriate scholarly perspective and a refined academic style.

## **Requirements of Manuscript Publication**

1. The manuscript must not exceed 25 pages as a maximum limit or be less than 12 pages as a minimum, approximately between 6500 to 7500 words on A4 paper. For the main text in Arabic, use size 15 Traditional Arabic font, and size 12 for footnotes, with a 1.5 line spacing. For studies in foreign languages, Times New Roman font size 12 should be used for the main text, with footnotes in size 11. The journal reserves the right to summarize or abbreviate texts that exceed the specified limit.
2. Each article must be accompanied by abstracts in both Arabic and French, along with an English abstract and an additional abstract in a language different from that of the article's text for articles in English (either Arabic or French), each ranging from 150 to 200 words. Articles will not be published without abstracts and keywords.
3. Authors are requested to submit a brief biography along with a recent digital photograph.
4. The journal is not obligated to return manuscripts to their authors, whether they are published or not. However, it commits to informing authors about the acceptance of their submissions for publication and to providing reasons for any rejections via the scientific journals' electronic portal.
5. The journal reserves the right to publish manuscripts according to its editorial plan and at a timing it deems appropriate.

6. The journal does not adhere to any specific ideological direction and is not subject to constraints other than those of science and its ethical standards. Therefore, the texts published in the journal reflect the views of their authors and do not necessarily represent the opinion of the journal.
7. Graphs and illustrative figures should be included within the text, with their titles and explanatory notes provided below them.
8. Footnotes should be placed at the end of the article and numbered within the text.
9. In-text citations should be formatted as follows: (Author, Year: Page). Subsequently, a list of sources and references, organized alphabetically by the author's last name and in accordance with the APA (American Psychological Association) style, should be provided at the end of the paper.
10. The journal is published quarterly, with issues released in January, April, July, and October.
11. Special issues of the journal may be published during the academic year if necessary.
12. Research papers or studies should be submitted via the journal's email or through its online portal.

## Editorial

This issue includes articles from various research fields, covering a range of diverse topics, some of which are interdisciplinary. For example, Bouhadjar's article re-examines an aspect of Virginia Woolf's 'To the Lighthouse' through the lens of Michel Foucault's Theory of Power. Meanwhile, Kouras' article explores linguistic realism in Algerian cinema, using Moknèche's trilogy as a starting point.

The theme of family is also prominent in this issue, covered from different angles in three articles. Saghir and Ben Sahell examine the impact of kinship relations on women's lives in the Algerian countryside, while Regad and Chaib assess the family's situation in the modern technology era. They focus on the cultural value crisis caused by social networks within the family context and explore the relationship between media and family values as addressed in media and communication research.

Benchohra's article attempts to historicize psychology, highlighting the contributions of the Arab-Islamic civilization and the challenges it faces today. Similarly, Mokhtari's article aims to compare practices of enslavement in the American South and in 19th-century Algeria.

Contrary to these historical analyses, other articles in this issue address contemporary topics. Mammeri and Benhafid evaluate the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on women's attitudes towards leisure sports, while Oussaidane discusses the spread of social media and the rise of citizen journalism as an end to traditional media's monopoly. Abbaci proposes a sociological approach to sustainable development within education.

Benzatat's article, which studies the geopolitical implications of Russian–Chinese relations in a multipolar international system, tackles a subject whose outcomes are yet to be fully realized.

This issue also includes two articles addressing significant methodological concerns. The first, by Bakir, deals with the obstacles that hinder the achievement of quality in educational scientific research. The second article, by Chiheb, explores an essential aspect of any research project: the ethical and pedagogical relationship between the student researcher and their supervisor. It discusses the foundation of this relationship and the practices necessary to fulfill its purpose.

Thus, in addition to maintaining its multidisciplinary nature, our journal also emphasizes its multilingual character. It hopes that readers and researchers will find what they are looking for in this issue and invites authors of serious works to submit their research papers through the journal's page on the Algerian Scientific Journal Platform (ASJP).
