

El-Bahith Review is an international **Open-Access**, peer refereed, indexed journal, established in 2002, dedicated to publication of original applied research in economics, commercial and management sciences. It is addressed to all researchers in research centers, academic entities, government departments and economic institutions. The journal accepts the articles in three languages: Arabic, English and French. The journal is published annually in June in both online and print versions, in two sections. Arabic section is devoted to the Arabic written articles and foreign languages section for the articles written in English or French languages.

The review policy is designed by Ouargla University Scientific Council within the context of the National Research Plan framework, with the supervision of the Scientific Council of Economics, Commercial and Management Sciences faculty and in collaboration with the review editorial board. The review publication, printing & distribution are ensured by the Publishing Directorate (University Scientific Publications) in coordination with the review editorial.

According to the European Index for Humanities scientific journals ERIH PLUS list, El-bahith review has been classified in Class (B), in 2019 the review has achieved the highest impact factor according to ASJP and ARCIF with the impact factors 0.1735, 0.1724 respectively. The periodical has also ranked among a number of scientific research engines, databases and international portals.

El-Bahith Review is an accredited journal by many national and international universities and academic institutions, where it is accepted in the scientific promotions, and in the committees of scientific expertise.

The review can be edited in special versions if it is necessary.



GUIDE TO AUTHORS

1- Submission of articles

We invite authors wishing to publish their articles of applied character, in "**El-Bahith review**" to consult the sections: "**Instructions to the authors**" and "**Guide to the authors**" of our space reserved on the platform of the Algerian scientific journals, via the following link:

Authors are invited to submit their paper proposals via ASJP in Word format. This can be done by clicking on the "**Paper submission**" heading to the right of the ASJP platform review area.

If the author has a "Username and Password" account for "**El-Bahith review**", go to "<u>Login</u>". And if the author needs a username and password ?, Go to "<u>Registration</u>".

Observation: Registration and login are required to submit an article online and to check the status of the submission.

2- Preparation of the article

In order to speed up the process of publishing articles in "**El-Bahith review**", the authors are invited to use the standard model of the Journal. A style sheet (template) is made available to authors in the "**instructions for authors**" section to insert their articles. Authors can download the template (RC_Template_English.doc) from the "**Instruction for Authors**" section.

3- Guidelines of the author

- Authors are invited to read and carefully follow these recommendations,

- The editor-in-chief has the right to return manuscripts that are not submitted in accordance with these recommendations.

4- Article Evaluation Process

As a first step, the article is examined anonymously at the level of the secretariat (internal committee) of the journal, which meets regularly and intervenes in the pre-evaluation phase. He gives a notice of eligibility of articles before sending to the associated publishers. If the article has not received a favorable opinion during this phase, it will be returned to the author with a sheet containing comments and suggestions. The author can resubmit it taking into account the recommendations made.

In a second step and in the case where the article is eligible for the evaluation (correct writing style, well-posed problematic, presence of research hypothesis, explicit methodology, etc.), it will be transmitted in double anonymity to the associate editor of the research area in question, who in turn will submit it to two evaluators of his network, who will take charge of the paper according to a standardized evaluation grid that they must obligatorily provide. The associated publisher can also evaluate the article if he wishes. The journal secretariat provides the interface between the authors of the articles and the associated editors.

When a draft article receives a favorable opinion and a negative one, a third evaluation is ordered, taking into account its origin, national or foreign. And the conclusion of the third arbitration will determine the acceptance result, which will be considered final.

In case of acceptance after the modification, the author of the article must make the required corrections within a period not exceeding one month.

If the article is accepted; The author must send the copyright transfer certificate (RC_Copyright Transfer and Declaration_English.doc), which can be downloaded from the journal's web space at the platform, under the heading "**Author guide**" this form of a compressed file.

5- The evaluation period of the articles

The evaluation period allowed to them is 45 days, but the evaluators take an average of two to three months to send to the secretariat of the journal.

Publication Ethics and Malpractice Statement

The publication of an article in a peer reviewed journal is an essential model for our journal "**El-Bahith Review** ". In order to provide our readers with a journal of highest quality we state the following principles of Publication Ethics and Malpractice Statement.

Our ethic statements are based on **COPE**'s Best Practice Guidelines for Journal Editors. It is necessary to agree upon standards of expected ethical behavior for all parties involved in the act of publishing: Editors, authors, and reviewers. Within **El-Bahith Review** are to be fully committed to good publication practice and accept the responsibility for fulfilling the following duties and responsibilities.

2) DUTIES OF REVIEWERS

- **Contribution to Editorial Decisions:** Peer review assists Editor-in-Chief and the Editorial Board in making editorial decisions and through the editorial communications with the author may also assist the author in improving the paper.
- **Promptness:** A selected referee who feels unqualified to review the research reported in a manuscript or knows that its prompt review will be impossible should notify the editor and decline to review the paper.
- **Confidentiality:** The manuscripts received for review will be treated as confidential documents. They will not be shown to or discussed with others except as authorized by the editor.
- **Standards of Objectivity:** Reviews should be conducted objectively. Personal criticism of the author is unacceptable. Referees should express their views clearly with supporting arguments.
- Acknowledgement of Sources: Reviewers should attempt to identify relevant published work that has not been cited by the authors. Any statement that a result or argument has been previously reported should be accompanied by the relevant citation. A reviewer should also call to the editor's attention any substantial similarity or overlap between the manuscript under consideration and any other published paper of which they have personal knowledge.
- **Disclosure and Conflict of Interest:** Privileged information or ideas obtained through peer review must be kept confidential and not used for personal advantage. Reviewers should not consider manuscripts in which they have conflicts of interest resulting from competitive, collaborative, or other relationships or connections with any of the authors, companies, or institutions connected to the papers.

3) DUTIES OF AUTHORS

• **Reporting standards:** Authors should accurately present their original research, as well as objectively discuss its significance. Manuscripts are to be edited in accordance to the submission guidelines of the review. Authors are also responsible for language editing before submitting the article. Underlying data should be represented accurately in the paper. A paper should contain sufficient detail and references to

permit others to replicate the work. Fraudulent or knowingly inaccurate statements constitute unethical behavior and are unacceptable.

- Originality and Plagiarism: The authors should ensure that they have written entirely original works, and if the authors have used the work and/or words of others that this has been appropriately cited or quoted. El-Bahith Review reserves the right to use plagiarism detecting software to screen submitted papers at all times.
- **Multiple, Redundant or Concurrent Publication:** An author should not in general publish manuscripts describing essentially the same research in more than one journal or conference. Submitting the same manuscript to more than one journal constitutes unethical publishing behavior and is unacceptable.
